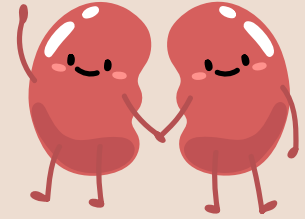


CKD Newsletter

patients over 10 practices have now attended the CKD education sessions. (See below for practice breakdown)

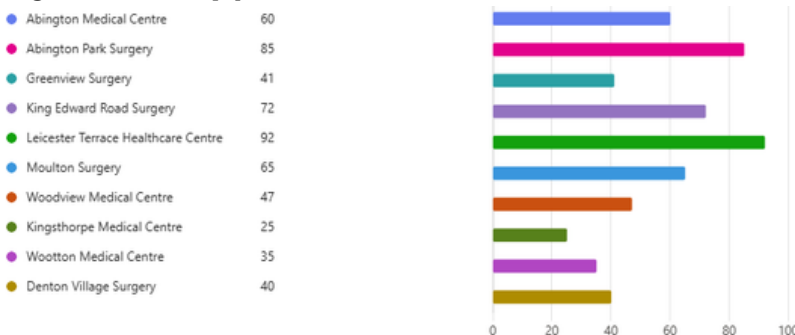
Referrals moving forwards
